## CAMP DIRECTORS



**Brian Wilson** – Head Coach, Connecticut College Coach Wilson just finished his first year as head coach at Connecticut College. His previous coaching experience included six years as an assistant at the College of the Holy Cross, two years at Western Kentucky University and one season at Williams College. Coach Wilson has been part of three NCAA Division I conference championship teams and has coached in three NCAA tournaments.

**Christie Herbst** – Assistant Coach, Connecticut College Coach Herbst is in her second year at Conn. A four-year letter-winner at St. Lawrence University, she helped lead her squad to a 24-4 record and a conference championship as a senior. Coach Herbst is involved with all aspects of running the basketball program at Conn. She works primarily with the perimeter players.

**Katie Wilson** – Assistant Coach, Connecticut College Katie was a Division I standout at the College of the Holy Cross. A four-year starter, she scored over 1500 career points, won three Patriot League Championships and played in three NCAA tournaments. A former high school head coach in New Hampshire, Katie works primarily with the posts at Conn.

### Connecticut College Facilities

All camp activities will be held indoors in the Connecticut College Athletic Center. All basketball related activities will take place on one of five full-length courts in Luce Fieldhouse.

### Equipment Needed

All campers must have basketball shoes, shorts or sweatpants and a t-shirt. Please no jewelry, watches or gum.

### Camp Store/Lunch

Campers will have a choice to bring a lunch or purchase a pizza from the camp store. Orders for pizza will be taken at drop-off time. Lunches will not be refrigerated by the camp: campers must either bring their own cooler or bring a lunch that does not require refrigeration.

The camp store will be open daily offering Gatorade, bottled water, & candy.

### State Certification

Connecticut College Girls Basketball Camp is fully licensed by the State of Connecticut. The camp is staffed by a certified athletic trainer and pool personnel approved by the State.

### ELIGIBILITY & FEES

Girls aged 7 – 15 are eligible. Connecticut College Girls' Basketball Camp fee is \$225.00. A \$150.00 deposit must accompany each application. A \$25.00 discount per camper is available for families with more than one child attending the camp and for Connecticut College faculty and staff families.

**REFUND:** If you decide not to attend camp after paying in full or after paying a deposit and notify the camp before July 1, 2010, you will receive a full refund. The deposit of \$150.00 is nonrefundable after July 1, 2010.

### PHYSICAL EXAMINATION

In accordance with State Health Department regulations, all campers must have a medical examination form on file with the camp (good for 3 years) prior to their participation in the Connecticut College Girls' Basketball Camp. Upon receiving a completed camp application each camper will receive by mail a medical form, a receipt of deposit and additional information regarding camp logistics.

### WAIVER AND INDEMNITY

Must be signed by parent/guardian for each camper. Your signature signifies that you agree to all of the terms contained herein. I certify that my child is in excellent health and may participate in strenuous physical activity at the Connecticut College Girls' Basketball Camp. Permission is granted for my child to receive emergency medical treatment if necessary.
