Teaching Position at Universidad San Francisco de Quito on San Cristobal, Galapagos

Job Description: Teach English to children, under age 12, beginning levels. 24 hours per week, mornings. Materials provided. 10 month contract with possibility to extend. Pay around \$650/month. Costs: Transport to Ecuador and Galapagos, visa (roughly \$80), housing and food while processing paperwork in Quito (approximately 1 week).

Desired Qualifications: Teaching certification, preferably elementary. Some experience preferred, but not required. Be flexible and open-minded. Be willing to live in a small island community. Be able to work a 10 month contract March-January. A basic knowledge of Spanish would be helpful.

Universidad San Francisco de Quito has an extension on San Cristobal, Galapagos. The university provides 2 and 4 year degrees to local students as well as a study abroad semester for international students. The university is launching a partnership with the Department of Education to provide trained English teachers for the local public schools. The Galapagos are a group of 15 islands, 4 populated, off the coast of Ecuador. The islands are well-known for their unique flora and fauna, much which is found nowhere else on the planet. The most populated island (Santa Cruz) has 25,000 people and the least-populated island (Floreana) has 130. San Cristobal has 6,000 inhabitants and Isabela has 2,000. Teachers will be placed on all 4 islands .
