**The Camel Hockey School**

Offered to boys and girls of all abilities from the ages 7 to 16. Camp will run August 10th-14th Monday to Friday from 9am – 3:00 pm daily. The schools focus will be fundamental skill development through high tempo drills and small games. The off-ice program will focus on learning the game, having fun, playing field games, shooting stations and conditioning.

Each camper will be on the ice 3 hours per day, participate in an off-ice program and attend a daily seminar. Campers can be dropped off at 8:30 am and picked up at 3:00 pm daily. Time will be made for a supervised lunch.

Groups will be divided based on age and ability.

Registration starts at 8:00 am-August 4th.

The cost of camp is \$350 per session with a \$25 discount for each additional sibling. Cost of tuition also covers the cost of a practice jersey. Payment must be received in full to assure a spot in school. All requests for cancellations must be made in writing no less than three weeks prior to the school. A \$50 administrative fee is non-refundable. Please return completed application and full payment as soon as possible. School will be filled on a first come basis.
