Students with a condition that is NOT permanently disabling who would like a related accommodation should contact Student Health Services or Student Counseling Services –depending on the type of impairment – to place the request each year. Included would be conditions that are temporary or less than substantially limiting to a major life activity, including recovery from an injury or surgical procedure and physical or mental health-related concerns. **HAND INTO OFFICE OF STUDENT HEALTH OR STUDENT COUNSELING SERVICES.**
