Students Studying Away in the Fall:

Congratulations! You have been accepted to a study away program for the Fall semester. This is an exciting time, and the last thing you want to worry about is your housing upon your return. With that in mind, we want to get you squared away even before you depart! Completing all of your paperwork before you leave ensures that our office has the information needed to place you in the most preferable assignment possible.



BEFORE YOU LEAVE:

- Complete the **STUDY AWAY STUDENT HOUSING APPLICATION** and the **HOUSING CONTRACT** and hand them in by the last day of classes for the spring semester. All information on the form is considered final and may not be changed after it is passed in.

All forms received after the last day of classes will be placed on a wait-list. Please be aware that a space may be secured on your behalf only after we receive your completed application and signed contract. Also, it is important to note that **the signed housing contract you submit is a binding commitment for College housing for the 2005-2006 academic year.**

- We will place you using the application form you completed as a guide, but housing placements are limited to the available spaces at the end of the fall semester.

WHILE YOU ARE AWAY:

- Students are responsible to verify that there is no outstanding balance on their student account, as this will prevent students from "cleared" by the College and appearing on the list of students to be placed in housing.
- Check this web-site and your Connecticut College e-mail account during the semester regarding any housing related information as well as to receive your finalized housing assignment in mid January.
