

2009 SUMMER HOUSING INFORMATION

1. Who is Eligible?

Summer housing is available for a limited number of Connecticut College students who are:

- Completing an academic internship for at least 20 hours per week with departmental supervision.
- Working with a faculty member to complete research or a project (including Keck Grant Scholars).
- Working for a campus office for a minimum of 20 hours per week.
- Enrolled in at least two summer courses at Connecticut College.
- Reunion Workers

Students may only reside on campus during the time they are employed or while the project, research, or classes are in session. All belongings must be removed from their rooms at the time of their departure.

2. Where will we live?

Summer residents will be housed in Hamilton and Abbey. Students whose internships or research include off campus responsibilities during MOST meal times, should indicate on their summer housing application that they are interested in being considered for housing in Abbey. Those students who are approved by the Office of Residential Education and Living to be housed in Abbey may also be approved to pay only room charges. Once those students are accommodated, other students with extenuating circumstances may be offered the opportunity to reside in Abbey, space permitting. Any student residing in Hamilton will be expected to pay for a meal plan.

Students will not be required to move to Transition Housing this year. They will remain in their Hamilton and Abbey summer assignments until the completion of Summer Housing on August 14th, 2009. On this date, Summer Housing residents returning as students in the fall will move into their fall 2009 housing assignments. Summer Housing residents not returning as students in the fall will not be provided housing after the 14th and are expected to completely vacate their Summer Housing room.

3. When will we move?

- Students may move into their summer housing assignments beginning on Friday, May 15th, at 9:00 AM and must be completely moved into their Summer Housing assignments by 9:00am on Monday, May 18th. The readiness of individual rooms in Hamilton and Abbey may affect the actual day summer housing students may begin their move, and they will be notified when their summer assignments are sent. Summer residents are allowed to remain on campus but are not allowed to attend Senior Week events, unless they are approved to do so.

- Students will pick up their keys and begin moving from summer housing to their fall '09 housing assignments on Friday, August 14th, 9:00 a.m. Students must complete their move into their fall assignments by 9:00 a.m. on Monday, August 17th.

THE COLLEGE DOES NOT PROVIDE ANY STORAGE FOR ANY STUDENTS. ANY ITEMS LEFT WILL BE REMOVED AND DISCARDED. STUDENTS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO MOVE FURNITURE FROM THEIR SUMMER ROOMS. ADDITIONALLY, ALL STUDENTS MUST CLEAN THEIR ROOMS COMPLETELY BEFORE MOVING OUT.

4. How much will it cost?

For students approved to stay on campus, room and board is mandatory and the cost is \$110.00 per week. Dining services will provide a minimum of 14 meals per week. Harris will be open for the summer residents and the snack shop will be available.

- If a student is housed in Abbey and is approved to pay only the cost of housing, the charge will be \$40.00 per week. These students will be responsible for their own meal preparation and daily upkeep in Abbey kitchen and will not be allowed in any dining halls during the summer. Anyone violating this expectation will be billed for the entire week and will be placed on a mandatory meal plan for the remainder of the summer.

- Students will be charged beginning the week of May 13th or, if they are moving at the end of the semester and returning later in the summer, they will be charged from the day they receive the key to their room. Residents will be charged for every week until a key is returned. Residents will not be reimbursed for room or meals for time away from campus for trips or vacations.

- The majority of summer students are responsible for their room and meal costs. Various departments or grants pay for a limited number of positions. If a department or grant is paying for your room and/or meals, you must fill out that information on the Summer Housing Application.

5. What more do I need to do?

Students applying for summer housing must return their completed application to the Office of Residential Education and Living by Wednesday, May 6th at 5:00 p.m. Rooms will be assigned by the Office of Residential Education and Living and mailed to students' campus mailboxes or sent via email by Tuesday, May 12th.

6. What are the Summer Housing residential policies?

- **NO LIVING ROOM SIGN OUTS OR PARTIES PERMITTED**
- **PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE WITH NOISE LEVEL**
- **THERE IS ZERO TOLLERANCE FOR ALL POLICY VIOLATIONS AND STUDENTS MAY BE ASKED TO LEAVE CAMPUS**
