## Purpose of the contest:

- To enhance student appreciation for New London and all it has to offer.

## Specifications:

Photographs **MUST** be taken in New London (for the purpose of this contest the Connecticut College campus is not an acceptable picture location).

There is no limit to the number of photographs that students may submit.

Photos may be color or black and white.

Photos may be submitted via email and/or hard copy.

## **Online Submissions:**

Fill out entry form (below) for each submission and email it, with the photograph to [lincc.committee@gmail.com](mailto:lincc.committee@gmail.com). Photos must be in jpeg format.

## **Hard Copies:**

Minimum print size of 5 x 7 inches.

Put photo(s) in box in the Holleran Center (in Cro near the Post Office).

Fill out the entry form for each submission and attach to your photo. Entry forms can be printed out here or are available in the Holleran Center.

## Honors:

### **Top 15 photographs:**

- Displayed for sale in a photography exhibit at the Hygienic Art Gallery in New London (Opening reception: April 26<sup>th</sup>, 7-10pm; Exhibition: 04/26/08-05/24/08).
- Published in *Underexposed*, the student photography magazine.
- Coverage by local newspapers.

### **Winning Photograph:**

- \$100 Cash prize to artist.
- Mounted and framed permanently on campus.

## Rules:

This contest is only open to Connecticut College students. All work must be original. Submissions will not be returned to artist. Artists whose work is in the top 15 nominated photographs must provide a hard copy of the photograph mounted on an 11 x 14 or a 16 x 20 matte. Artists should be aware that Hygienic Art Gallery will take a small commission on any photographs that are sold. Nominated artists will be allowed but not required to submit a write-up about their work. On the opening night of the exhibition viewers will be able to vote on their top 3 photographs. These votes will contribute to the final voting on the winning photograph. Photographs will be judged based on artistic and aesthetic quality and portrayed appreciation of New London's beauty.
