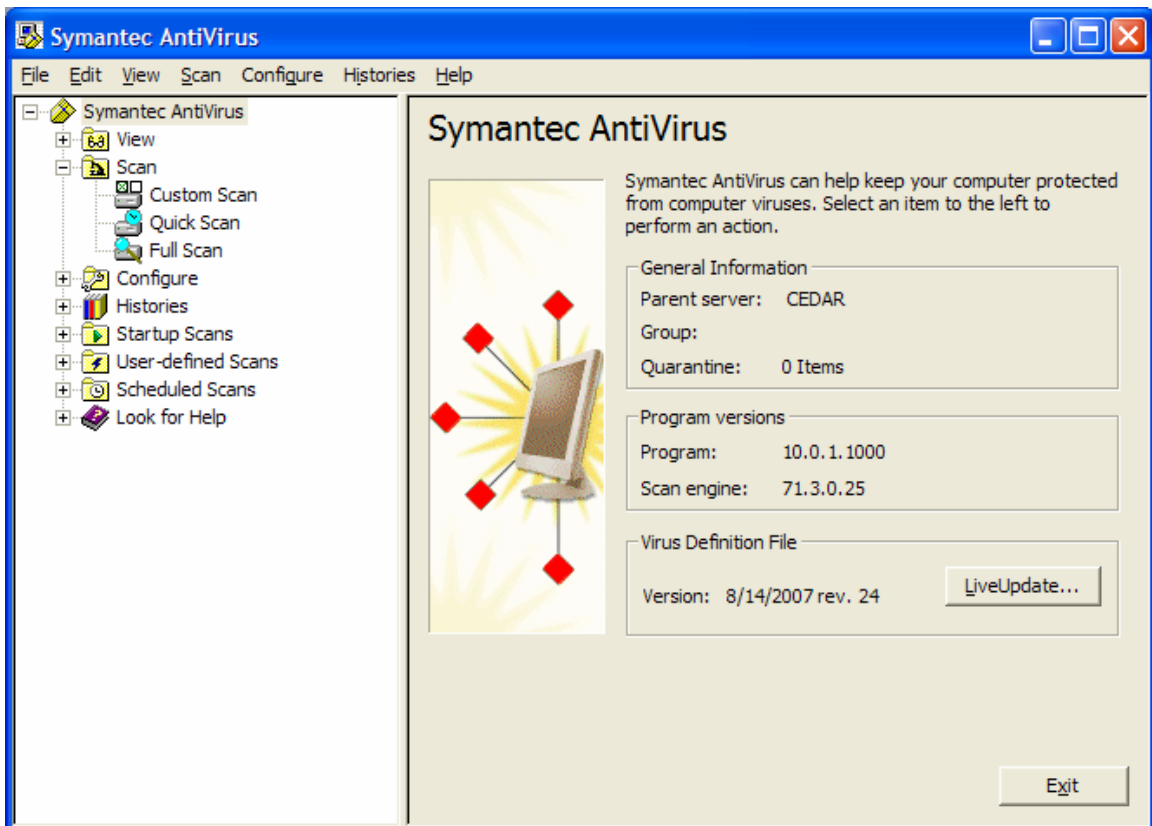


Clean Access Preparation/Installation

Clean Access Preparation

In order to make the installation of Clean Access as simple and smooth as possible, please take the following steps before the day Clean Access is turned on in your building.

1. Run Windows update by going to Start, All Programs, Windows Update. Download the high priority updates. If you have not been doing this on a regular basis, you may need to do it several times before all the high priority updates are downloaded.
2. Make sure that you have virus protection installed and that the virus definitions are no more than 5 days old. If your virus protection was supplied by Connecticut College, you can go to All Programs, Symantec Client Security, and click on Symantec Antivirus. You will see a screen similar to the one below. On this sample screen you can see that the virus definition file is dated 8/14/2007. If the definition file on your computer is more than 5 days old, you must click on the LiveUpdate button to get a more recent one.



3. If you do not have any virus protection, you can go to <http://cedar.conncoll.edu> to install it.

Clean Access Installation

1. Turn on or reboot your machine.


2. Run Internet Explorer.

3. Go to any Web site that does not belong to Connecticut College, such as www.dell.com. This will automatically bring up the Cisco Clean Access Authentication screen below.

4. Enter your Connecticut College username and password and click on continue.

5. Click on the button that says “Download Clean Access Agent”.

You are required to use the SmartEnforcer Client to Continue your login to the College's network.

By accepting this process you agree to hold to the College harmless for any loss or damages that may result from operating system updates or the installation of the required programs.

Check the box to launch the client, you should find the SmartEnforcer icon in the system tray (in the lower right hand corner of your screen). Otherwise, you must launch the client by searching the programs menu, finding Perfigo, and then executing SmartEnforcer.

Download Clean Access Agent 4.1.1.0

Note: If you are already running the Clean Access Agent and you are connected through a slower connection (such as VPN or dial-up), please wait as it might take a few moments for the Agent to pop up.

6. Click on Run.

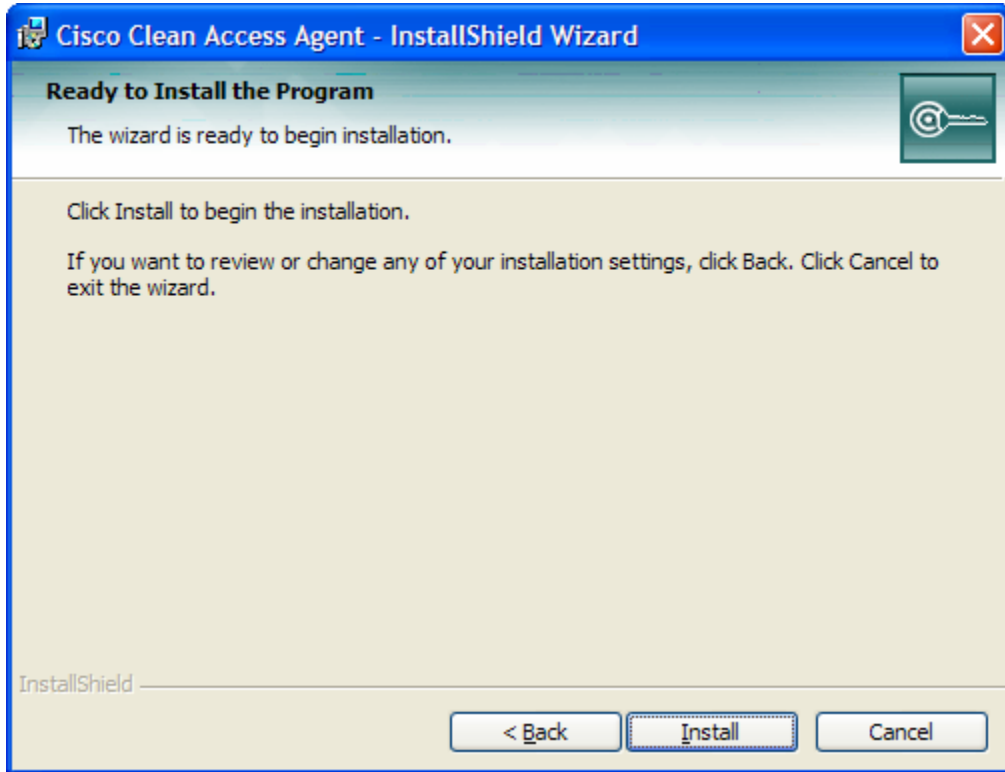


7. Click on Run again.

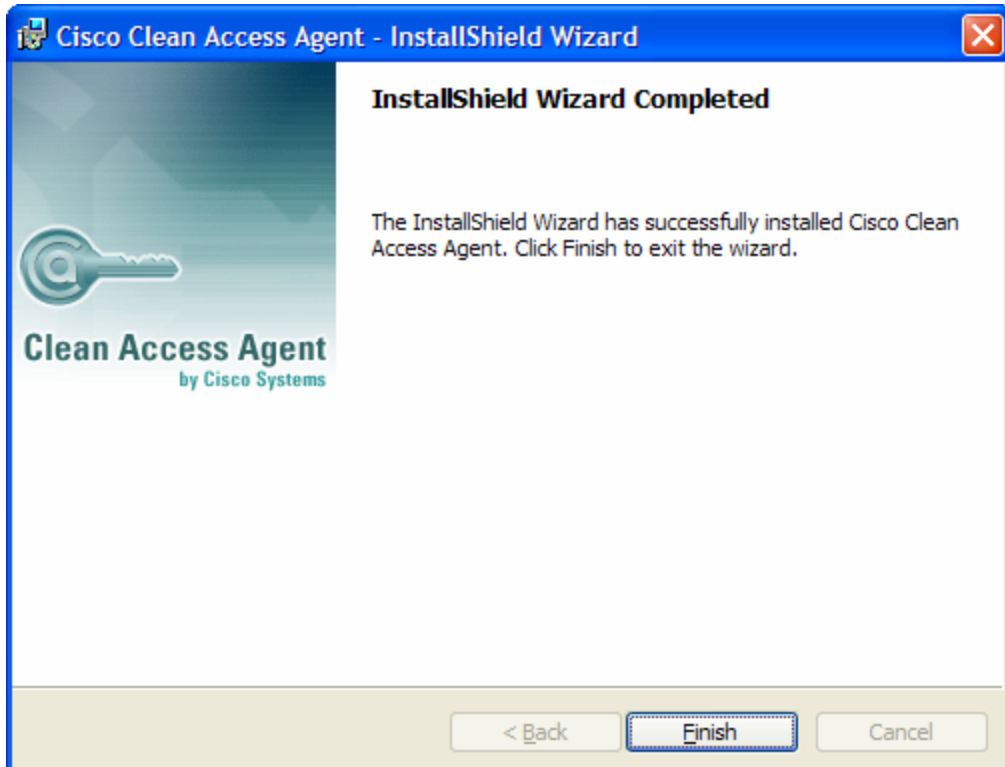

8. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the Clean Access Agent. Accept all of the defaults and click on “Next” in each screen until you see the Ready to Install screen below. Click on Install.



9. Click on Finish.

10. The Clean Access Agent will now run, as it will each morning. Enter your college username and password.
