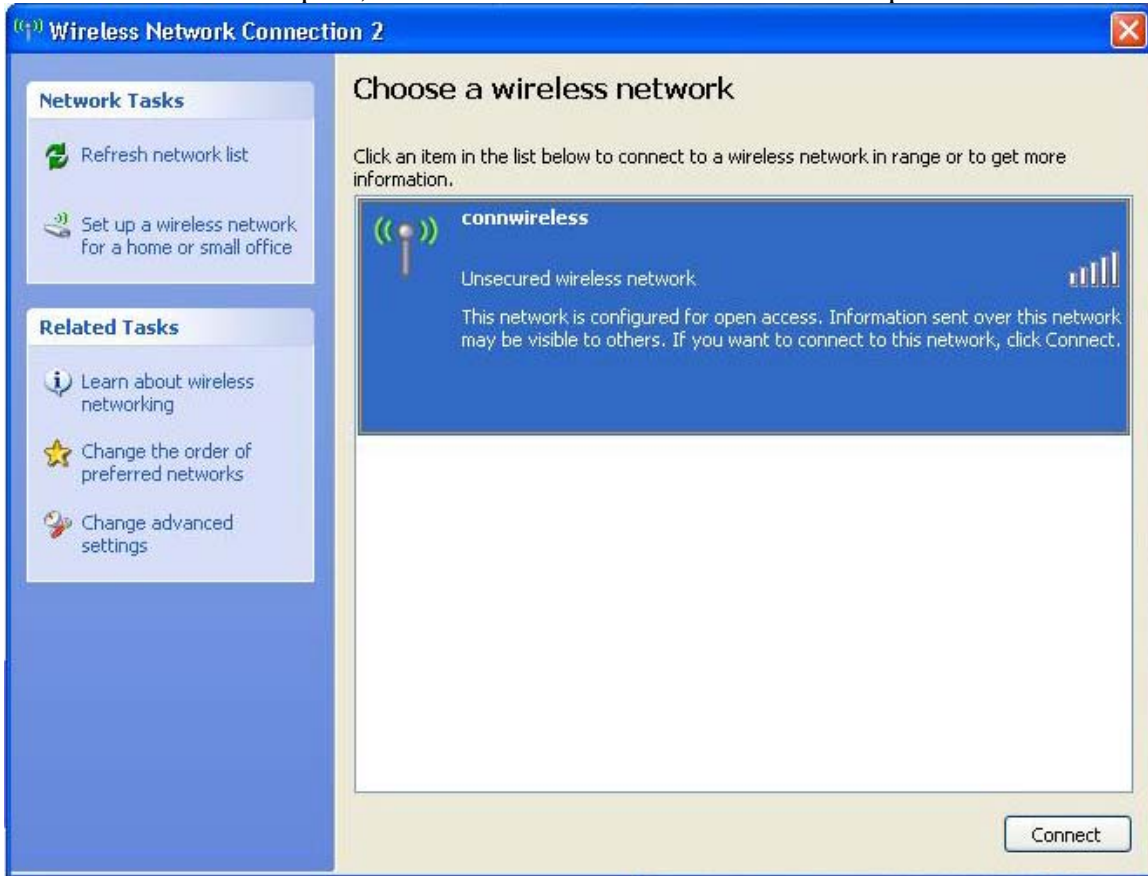


Wireless Instructions - Windows XP

1. To configure a wireless connection in Windows Xp, first right-click on the wireless icon in the bottom right corner of the screen, and select “View Available Wireless Networks”.



2. In the window that opens, select the network “ConnWireless” and press Connect.

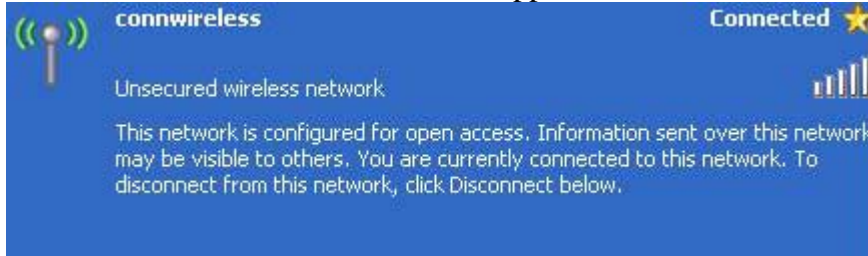


3. Select “Connect Anyway” in the security window that appears.

4. The word “Connected” should now appear with the network ConnWireless.



5. Run Internet Explorer.

6. Choose to “Continue to this website” in the message that appears.

8. Agree to download the Cisco Clean Access Manager.

You are required to use the SmartEnforcer Client to Continue your login to the College's network.

By accepting this process you agree to hold to the College harmless for any loss or damages that may result from operating system updates or the installation of the required programs.

Check the box to launch the client, you should find the SmartEnforcer icon in the system tray (in the lower right hand corner of your screen). Otherwise, you must launch the client by searching the programs menu, finding Perfigo, and then executing SmartEnforcer.

Download Clean Access Agent 4.1.1.0

Note: If you are already running the Clean Access Agent and you are connected through a slower connection (such as VPN or dial-up), please wait as it might take a few moments for the Agent to pop up.

9. Select Save and then run the application from your desktop when it has finished downloading.



10. Press Run to allow the program to begin the install.



11. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the Clean Access Agent. You should not have to modify any of the settings.

12. Run the Clean Access Agent, and enter your college username and password.
