

Part-Time Visiting Professor of Computer Science

Connecticut College is seeking a visiting professor (rank open) for a one year part-time position in computer science to begin in August, 2010. Applicants should have a strong commitment to excellence in undergraduate teaching and an active research program. Applicants must have at least a Masters (PhD preferred) or equivalent in Computer Science or related field. Candidates with research interests in any area of computer science will be considered. Successful candidates must have the ability to teach core courses in computer science (including Algorithms, Operating Systems, and Programming Languages) and their area of expertise. The annual teaching load for full-time visiting professors is six courses and for part-time it is four. Salary and benefits are competitive.

Research is emphasized in the computer science department through its introduction in the classroom and direct involvement by students; majors are required to complete at least two semesters of independent study research. The computer science spaces currently include a Virtual Reality / Sound lab, Unix lab (equipped with Sun workstations running Unix and Dell workstations running Linux), Hardware/Networks lab, and Robotics lab.

Connecticut College is a private, highly selective institution with a demonstrated commitment to outstanding faculty teaching and research. Recognizing that intellectual vitality and diversity are inseparable, the College has embarked on a significantly successful initiative to diversify its faculty, student body and curriculum. The College seeks creative scholars excited about working in a liberal arts setting, with its strong focus on engaged teaching, participation in shared governance, and active involvement in an institution-wide advancement of diversity. We value the contributions visitors bring to our community and encourage their active engagement with their departments and all aspects of campus life during the course of their appointment. The presence of visiting faculty members is welcome at all faculty meetings.
