Important Information

- The initial award is an estimate. You will be required to submit federal tax returns and supporting documentation in order to determine the final award. Staff will review this supporting documentation but *no earlier* than April 1. It is possible that the final award will be less than the initial award. If you are concerned about any potential adjustment and its impact on your family's contribution, you should reconsider applying Early Decision.
- State grants are provided by various states for eligible students based on financial need and/or academic qualifications. Those states have specific application deadlines. Check page 4 for deadlines and links.
- Our staff will require the 2010 - 2011 FAFSA and your 2009 federal tax returns with supporting documents no later than May 1, 2010 for verification purposes. If documents are received after 5/1, you risk a late penalty.
