
The Department of Classics and the First Year Identity Seminars present



a 30-minute original musical composition for solo acoustic guitar and voice, which tells the story of Homer's *Odyssey* in a series of 24 short songs composed and performed by Joe Goodkin.

Drawing on his Bachelor's Degree in the Classics from the University of Wisconsin - Madison, his extensive experience teaching private music lessons, and his years of writing and performing original rock and acoustic music, Joe Goodkin has created a 30-minutelong composition for solo acoustic guitar and voice, which tells the story of *The Odyssey* in song, invoking the spirit of the ancient Greek bards who originally brought forth the timeless stories of Odysseus and the heroes of the Trojan War.

The Odyssey was honored in 2003, 2004, and 2012 with an American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP) Award.
