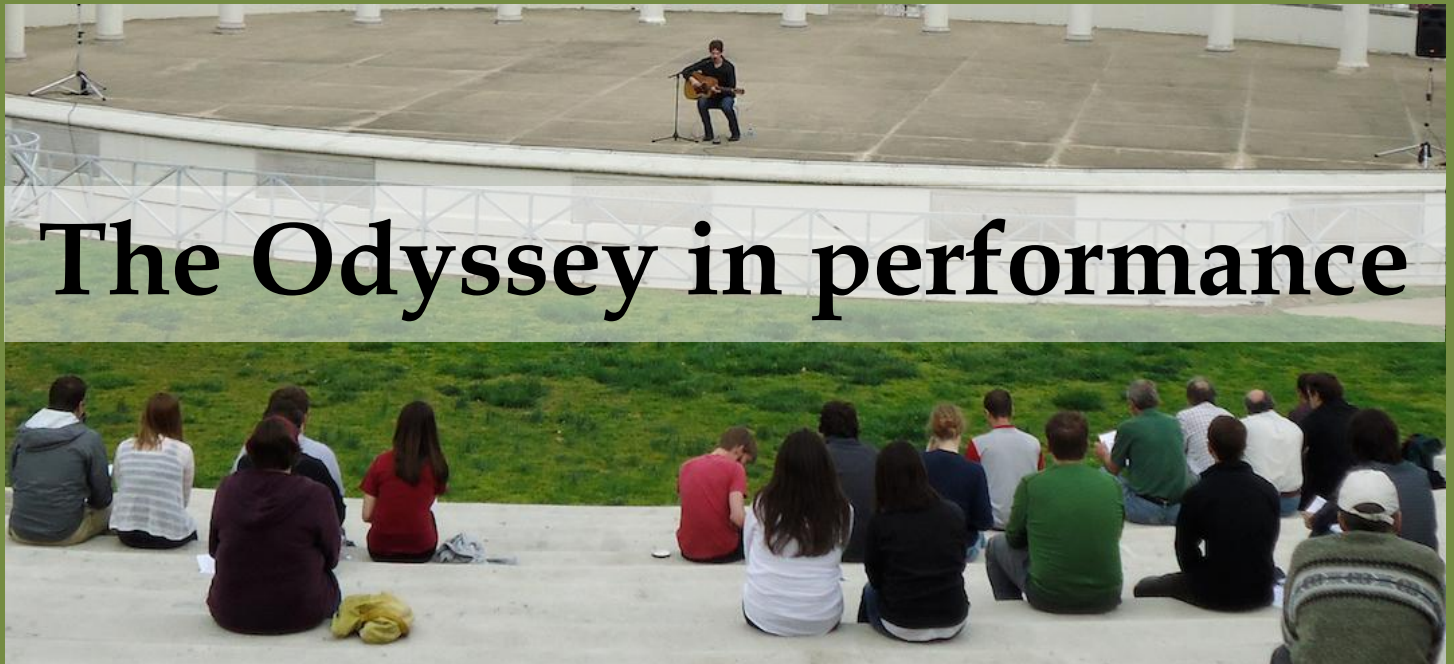


# The Department of Classics and the First Year Identity Seminars present

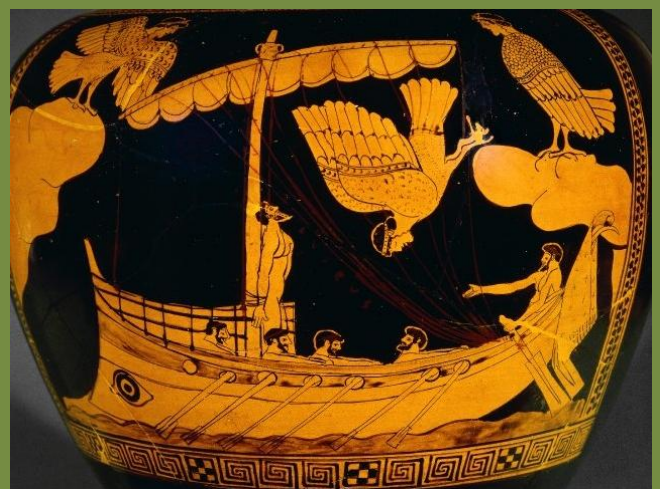

Drawing on his Bachelor's Degree in the Classics from the University of Wisconsin - Madison, his extensive experience teaching private music lessons, and his years of writing and performing original rock and acoustic music, Joe Goodkin has created a 30-minute-long composition for solo acoustic guitar and voice, which tells the story of *The Odyssey* in song, invoking the spirit of the ancient Greek bards who originally brought forth the timeless stories of Odysseus and the heroes of the Trojan War.

*The Odyssey* was honored in 2003, 2004, and 2012 with an American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers (ASCAP) Award.
