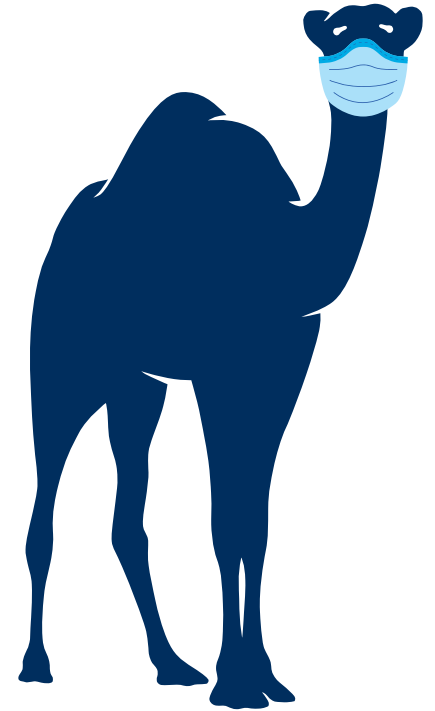


# CAMELS CARE

## A PLEDGE TO STOP THE SPREAD OF COVID-19

*During the 2021-2022 academic year, Connecticut College will resume more normal operations on campus, and Camels will need to continue to take extraordinary steps to keep our community healthy and stem the spread of COVID-19 across campus and into our communities.*

*As a member of the Connecticut College community, I understand I must take responsibility for my own health and adhere to the campus COVID-19 expectations to protect the health of the faculty, staff, and students.*



### AS A CAMEL, I PLEDGE TO:

#### 1. PROTECT MYSELF

- Monitor for the symptoms of COVID-19 and report to medical professionals if I experience a fever of 100.4 F (38 C) or higher, dry cough, difficulty breathing, chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat or loss of taste or smell.
- Wash my hands often with soap and water or use hand sanitizer
- Get vaccinated for the flu this fall

#### 2. PROTECT OTHERS

- Follow the expectations set by the College related to mask wearing and social distancing based on whether I am vaccinated or unvaccinated.
- Stay home if I feel ill
- Abide by the directions for isolation, quarantine or other precautions I must take if I test positive for COVID-19 or have been notified that I have been exposed to a person testing positive.
- Be positive, sensitive and helpful to anyone around who may be troubled or struggling
- Keep myself informed of the latest guidance and expectations developed by the College and follow these expectations. I will carefully review emails related to COVID-19 and regularly refer to the Path Forward website for the latest information.

#### 3. PROTECT CONN

- Participate in testing (as directed) and fully cooperate with contact tracing to preserve the wellness of the community
- Carefully observe instructional signs and follow directions
- Follow expectations for safe engagement in the New London County community and for travel beyond New London County.
