PARKING OPTIONS

You have three choices for parking at Connecticut College:

- South Lot (nearest the open house events)
- North Lot (if South Lot is full)
- Athletic Center (recommended if you'll be taking a tour of the Athletic Center)

SHUTTLES WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR THOSE PARKING AT THE ATHLETIC CENTER AND NORTH LOT

- Morning: Vans will run between 7:45-9 a.m. between the lots and the area near where you will check in for the open house (Castle Court). These loops take about 5-7 minutes.
- Afternoon: Vans will run between 12:45-2 p.m. from Castle Court to the Athletic Center and North Lot. These loops take about 5-7 minutes.

After you've parked, wait for the vans near the signs reading Shuttle Stop.

DIRECTIONS TO PARKING OPTIONS

SOUTH LOT

From New York and South: From I-95 North take Exit 83. Make a left at the light at the end of the exit. Go to the next light, and turn right past

- the entrance to the Coast Guard Academy onto Route 32 North. At the second stop light, turn left onto the main campus. At the Gate house, turn left. Follow that road until your first road on the left. Take a left and you are in the South Lot.
- From Hartford: Take Route 2 East to its end onto Route 395 South (Exit 28S). Travel approximately eight miles to Exit 5 (left exit) and get on Route 32 South. Continue on Route 32 South until you pass beneath a pedestrian bridge. At the second light after the pedestrian bridge turn right onto the main campus. At the Gatehouse, turn left. Follow that road until your first road on the left. Take a left and you are in the South Lot.
- From Rhode Island and the North: From I-95 South take Exit 84N. This will bring you onto Route 32 North. At the second light, turn left onto the main campus. At the Gatehouse, turn left. Follow that road until your first road on the left. Take a left and you are in the South Lot.

ATHLETIC CENTER (RECOMMENDED IF YOU PLAN TO TOUR THE AC AT THE END OF THE OPEN HOUSE PROGRAMMING.)

- Enter Dayton Arena into your GPS and follow those directions.
- From New York and the South: From I-95 North take Exit 83. Make a left at the light at the end of the exit. Go to the next light, and turn right past the entrance to the Coast Guard Academy onto

- Route 32 North. Turn right at the third stop light. You will see a sign for the AC.
- From Hartford: Take Route 2 East to the end onto Route 395 South (Exit 28S). Travel approximately eight miles to Exit 5 (left exit) and get on Route 32 South. Continue on Route 32. Make a left at the first light after the pedestrian bridge into the AC.
- From Rhode Island and the North: From I-95 South take Exit 84N. This will bring you onto Route 32 North. At the third stop light, turn right. You will see a sign for the AC.

NORTH LOT

- From New York and South: From I-95 North take Exit 83. Make a left at the light at the end of the exit. Go to the next light, and turn right past the entrance to the Coast Guard Academy onto Route 32 North. At the third stop light, turn left onto Benham Ave. Once on Benham Ave, look for a sign indicating to turn left for the open house. In a few hundred feet, you'll see a sign taped to a pole indicating where to veer right for the North Lot.
