## **FUNDED SOPHOMORE SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM** FOR STUDENTS IN PATHWAYS AND CENTERS

The Funded Sophomore Research Program will provide a \$3000 scholarship for Pathway or Center students conducting research during the summer following their sophomore year. The research must be related to the student's animating questions, projects or research in their Pathway or Center.

Selected students will receive a \$3,000 stipend for 300 hours during which the research work is done. The student may complete the research on or off campus, and may be completed remotely. If you choose to conduct this research on campus, housing will be covered in addition to the \$3000 stipend, but not food. Regular contact by email, phone, or skype is required with the faculty sponsor. Students will be expected to participate in a presentation in the fall semester following the award.

  - e. Address the need for IRB approval on any participant research, if applicable.
- Paragraph from Pathway Coordinator or Faculty Director (ONLY if the Faculty Sponsor is not the Pathway Coordinator or Center Director)
  - a. Relevance of the student's research to the Pathway or Center
- Transcript
- Resume
