Early Decision 1 - Requirements due by November 15, 2018

Early Decision 2 – Requirements due by January 16, 2019

Regular Decision – Requirements due by January 16, 2019

For International students: If you wish to be considered for financial aid, you must submit a completed financial aid application at the time of applying for admission. You can request an updated financial aid review in subsequent years if significant changes to your family's finances have occurred. Please see below for application requirements.

- Noncustodial Parent's Profile, if applicable** - If your parents are divorced, separated, or were never married, your noncustodial parent is required to complete the Noncustodial Parent's PROFILE online. Once the custodial parent has submitted the CSS PROFILE, the student will receive an email with instructions from the College Board to provide to the noncustodial parent. This information is needed so that the noncustodial parent can access the Noncustodial Parent's PROFILE application.

- Verification of Parent Income** – Custodial parent tax return or letter from employer

- Verification of Noncustodial Parent Income, if applicable** – Noncustodial parent tax return or statement from employer

- Non-Tax Filer Statement, if applicable** – if you did not file a tax return or have a statement from employer, please submit a Non-Tax Filer Statement(s).
