Early Decision I - Requirements due by November 15, 2022

Early Decision II – Requirements due by January 15, 2023

Regular Decision – Requirements due by January 15, 2023

For International students: If you wish to be considered for financial aid, you must submit a completed financial aid application at the time of applying for admission. You can request an updated financial aid review in subsequent years if significant changes to your family's finances have occurred. Please see below for application requirements. You do not have to apply for need-based financial aid to be considered for a merit scholarship.

 - There is a fee; Connecticut College does not offer fee waivers.
- Noncustodial Parent's Profile, if applicable** - If your parents are divorced, separated, or were never married and are living apart, your noncustodial parent is required to complete the Noncustodial Parent's PROFILE online if you are applying for institutional grant aid. The student can enter the noncustodial email address in their College Board portal and College Board will notify the noncustodial parent they can enter their noncustodial application.
- Verification of Parent Income** – Most recent custodial parent tax return or updated letter from employer (translated to English)
- Verification of Noncustodial Parent Income, if applicable** – Most recent Noncustodial parent tax return or updated statement from employer (translated to English)
- Non-Tax Filer Statement, if applicable** – if you did not file a tax return or have a statement from employer, please submit a Non-Tax Filer Statement(s).
