- ☐ **2026-2027 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** – available for online completion on October 1, 2025 at: <https://studentaid.gov/h/apply-for-aid/fafsa>
- **Title IV school code: 001379**
  - This form is required to determine your eligibility for federal and state grants, federal loans, and federal student employment. Not required to be considered for a merit scholarship.
- ☐ **2026-2027 CSS PROFILE Application** – available for online completion on October 1, 2025 at:

- **CSS school code: 3284**
  - This form is required to determine eligibility for need-based institutional grant aid only. It is not necessary to complete this form if you wish to be considered for a merit scholarship, or if you are only applying for federal and state grants, loans, and/or student employment.

    - Parent(s) 2024 W-2 forms
    - Noncustodial 2024 signed federal tax return with all schedules, statements, and W-2 forms, if applicable
    - 2024 Corporate and/or Partnership federal tax return(s) and Schedule K-1(s), if applicable
- ☐ **Noncustodial Parent's Profile** – if applicable
- If your parents are divorced, separated, or were never married and are living apart, your noncustodial parent is required to complete the Noncustodial Parent CSS Profile online if you are applying for need-based institutional grant aid. College Board will provide the student with more information regarding the process to send notification of the Noncustodial CSS Profile to their noncustodial parent after the Custodial CSS Profile has been completed.
