→ *Speak Selection & Speak Screen*: Speak Selection and Speak Screen are both able to read on-screen text. However, with Speak Selection enabled, the user must highlight the text first whereas Speak Selection will read the entire screen's contents.

◆ To enable Speak Selection:

- Tap on the “Settings” app then tap on “General” and then tap on “Accessibility”
- Tap on “Speech” and then enable “Speak Selection” tapping the on/off toggle
- Once Speak Selection is activated, the user can then customize their experience through the options given
- *\*For all auditory related visual aids, it is best advised to download the “Alex” voice which is a high quality U.S. English voice that delivers a natural sounding speech\**

◆ To use Speak Selection:

- Highlight the body of text you would like read, then click “Speak” on the black taskbar that appears

◆ To enable Speak Screen:

- Tap on the “Settings” app then tap on “General” and then tap on “Accessibility”
- Tap on “Speech” and then enable “Speak Screen” tapping the on/off toggle
- Once Speak Screen is activated, the user can then customize their experience through the options given
- *\*For all auditory related visual aids, it is best advised to download the “Alex” voice which is a high quality U.S. English voice that delivers a natural sounding speech\**

◆ To use Speak Screen:

- Once Speak Screen is enabled, simply use two fingers to scroll down on a page you want read and Speak Screen will begin
